Objective(s): <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ We will facilitate, in a content-neutral manner, the rights of all individuals to assemble and the rights to express their views.➤ To quickly and effectively respond to any crowd management event(s) effecting Interstate 5 to safeguard motorists, protestors and law enforcement officers.➤ Establish alternative travel routes to ensure the constant flow of vehicular traffic around the protest area.➤ Assist allied public safety agencies as needed.															
4. Operational Period Command Emphasis: <p>Washington State Patrol (WSP) and Washington Department of Transportation (WSDOT) employees will provide staffing to properly close the southbound lanes of Interstate 5 at State Route 14 in response to a planned protest and roadway closure. WSP in partnership with WSDOT will redirect southbound vehicular traffic to Interstate 205 via State Routes 500 and 14. WSP and WSDOT employees will establish control points to southbound Interstate 5 at 39th Street, 4th Plain, Mill Plain, Washington Street and westbound State Route 14 at City Center. Additionally, WSP and WSDOT employees will stage northbound Interstate 5, just north of the bridge, in case protestors cross over the jersey barriers and enter the northbound lanes.</p>															
General Situational Awareness: <p>According to the Vancouver Police Department, On June 19, 2020 from 1600 to 1900 a planned protest/demonstration will occur at Esther Short Park in downtown Vancouver. Current information indicates the protestors plan to walk onto Interstate 5 and block vehicular traffic as they travel southbound across the bridge. Additional information exists to believe a similar group in Portland, Oregon will travel northbound across the bridge at the same time. WSP and WSDOT will provide traffic control services in support of the protest to ensure the safety of protestors, the motoring public and law enforcement personnel.</p>

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3. Safety Message/Expanded Safety Message, Safety Plan, Site Safety Plan:

- Use of issued reflectorized vest will be required while performing manual traffic control
- Units working shall monitor their radios during this event to ensure proper communication channels remain open for the purposes of facilitating traffic control, calls for service and officer safety
- Traffic control training points should be considered when performing traffic control during this event:
 - 1 - Traffic control is one of the most dangerous duties, yet it is often taken lightly
 - 2 - If performing traffic control duties, ensure your vehicle is parked in an appropriate location
 - 3 - Leave yourself an escape route in case you encounter a distracted and/or impaired driver
 - 4 - Be familiar with the warning devices in place and how they help protect you and facilitate the traffic flow
 - 5 - Ensure you utilize proper communications
 - 6 - Maintain your composure as your emotional escalation may influence driving behavior
 - 7 - Have a plan for collisions that may occur in the traffic control pattern
 - 8 - Be consistent and understand who has the right of way when directing traffic
 - 9 - Be aware of pedestrian traffic
 - 10 - Your safety is **most** important
